Findings Include: 1. R1's Minimum Data Set (MDS), dated [DATE], documents that R1 is cognitively intact. On 3/06/2020 at 12:00 PM, R1 stated, I've told them that my bed is too hard but they didn't give me a new one and I have to keep sleeping on the same old uncomfortable mattress. My mattress is so uncomfortable it makes it hard to sleep. I am so tired when I wake up in the morning. Why can't they give me a different mattress. This mattress is lumpy and uncomfortable and my body hurts in the morning and I have to take medicine because of the pain in my body just because of the mattress. On 3/6/2020 at 12:10 PM, R1's mattress looks slightly lumpy in appearance. On 3/06/2020 at 10:00 AM, the bottom of R1's top chest drawer was rusted out on the entire bottom of the drawer. If you run your hand on the bottom of the drawer, a rust colored substance residue was left behind. On 3/06/2020 at 3:59 PM, R1 stated, I don't like it that my dresser drawer is rusted out and I do not have a top drawer to put my clothes in. I like to have the top drawer because it is easier to get in and out of for me. I hurt my leg and I am in a wheelchair. 2. R2's MDS, dated [DATE], documents R2 is cognitively intact. On 3/06/2020 at 10:15 AM, R2 stated, My bathroom flooring is filthy. The floors are cracked and are not in good condition. I am afraid I will cut my foot going in there or get some type of fungal infection. My toilet is constantly running, and there is water on the floor. It grosses me out just going in there. I am frightened to go into my own bathroom. On 3/06/2020 at 10:18 AM, R2's toilet was running, and there was water on the floor. The water was a small puddle of water the size of a watermelon. The floor is dark colored with patches of different colors around the edges. The coating is chipped off in multiple various places covering the entire shower area. On the sides of the shower, the paint was peeling off. There was a strong mildew odor in the bathroom. The handles to the handicapped bathroom seat were chipped and uneven. The shower drain was rusty in appearance. On 3/06/2020 at 10:15 AM, the bottom of R2's first of four chest drawers is rusted, and a hand written note was found in the drawer. The undated note documents, Please don't put clothing in this drawer, because rust will get on the clothing. If you run your hand on the bottom of the drawer, a rust colored residue was left behind. On 3/6/2020 at 11:30 AM, V5, Family of R2, stated her mother has told her that she was scared to go to the bathroom, and it frightens her because the tiles are missing, and the bathroom is just not clean looking. I told (V1) about it, but he didn't do anything about trying to fix it. On 3/6/2020 at 12:05 PM, R2's dresser was observed, and when V4, Maintenance, saw the drawers he stated, I was not aware (R2's) drawer looked like that I will make sure it gets painted and lined. I haven't gotten any work orders for it so I didn't know it needed repaired. V4 also stated, (R2's) floor was not a tile floor, but rather it was some kind of laminate floor from the 1970's which had never been replaced. I will have to first fill the holes in, then I will repair it. On 3/6/2020 at 3:56 PM, V5, R2's daughter, stated, My mom's dresser drawer was rusted out on the bottom really bad. I had to put a note on the drawer telling my mom not to use it because of the rust getting on her clothes and ruining them. I told the Administrator (V1) about it, but it didn't seem to bother him that her drawer was rusted. 3. R3's MDS, dated [DATE], documents R3 is moderately cognitively impaired. On 3/06/2020 at 11:47 AM, R3's bathroom tile has multiple chipped areas. The base board was hanging off of the wall, and the toilet has brown staining around the toilet bowl. There was a strong mildew smell in the bathroom. On 3/6/2020 at 11:47 AM, R3 stated, The bathroom was not very pleasant to go into and the tiles and walls needed to be repaired. R3 also stated there was a strong mildew odor scent that never seems to go away. On 3/06/2020 at 11:47 AM, both of the chest of drawers assigned to R3 are rusted on the bottom of the drawers. If you run your hand on the bottom of the drawer, a rust colored substance residue was left behind. On 3/6/2020 at 11:49 AM, R3 stated, I hang all of my clothing. I only put underwear in the drawers. I would not put anything in there because it will get rust on it and it is hard to get rust out of your clothes. 4. R4's MDS, dated [DATE], documents R4 is moderately cognitively impaired. On 3/06/2020 at 10:50 AM, R4's bathroom has multiple chipped tiles on the floor. The sides of the shower room the paint is peeling. There was a strong mildew smell present. On 3/06/2020 at 10:50 AM, R4 stated, They need to repair the bathrooms in the building. Things need fixed over time, things get old. They need to repair things around here. The bathroom is not the most pleasant thing around here but I do not like to complain. On 3/06/2020 at 10:50 AM, R4's top chest drawer is rusted in the bottom of the drawer. If you run your hand on the bottom of the drawer, a rust colored residue was left behind. On 3/06/2020 at 10:50 AM, R4 stated, he did not understand why they could not paint the bottom or put something inside of it so the rust would not get on other things. 5. R5's MDS, dated [DATE], documents R5 is cognitively intact. On 3/06/2020 at 10:55 AM, R5's bathroom has multiple chipped tiles and the paint is peeling. There was a strong mildew odor in the bathroom. The drain was rusty around the edges. On 3/06/2020 at 10:55 AM, R5 stated, Yes, there are chipped tiles in here and the paint is peeling in some areas. On 3/06/2020 at 10:55 AM, the entire bottom of both of R5's chest drawers are rusted out. If you run your hand on the bottom of the drawer, a rust colored substance residue was left behind. On 3/06/2020 at 10:55 AM, R5 stated, I do not put anything in there that I care about because it will get stained from the rust. On 3/6/2020 at 11:AM, V6, Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), stated, Yes, there are a few residents on this (200 hall) hall with rusted drawers. There's been a few maintenance orders for them to be fixed. I don't know how long they have been like that, for at least a few weeks. We put in a work order when we something that needs fixed. There have been a few maintenance orders for the drawers to be fixed. On 3/6/2020 at 11:15 AM, V7, CNA, stated, Yes there are some residents that have rusted out drawers on this hall (200 Hall). We put in a work order whenever we see anything like that. I know a work order has been put in for the drawers for maintenance to look at the drawers. I am not sure how long the drawers have been like that. Several weeks. The facility form Maintenance Work Order, dated 1/28/2020 through [DATE]20, did not document work orders for these chest of drawers. On 3/6/2020 at 12:03 PM, V4, Maintenance, stated, I know we had had some dresser drawers that I had to put liners inside and/or paint. I am not aware of any other dresser drawers currently needing repaired. The facility form Maintenance Work Order, dated 01/28/2020 through [DATE]20, did not document a work order for R1's, R2's, R3's, R4's or R5's bathroom flooring, toilet or shower. On 3/06/2020 at 12:05 PM, V1, Administrator, stated he was not aware of any complaints from family members and/or residents regarding any issues with showers, toilets and/or mattresses. V1 also stated, No one has complained to me about rusted drawers. If we have a problem, we just swap them out or put in a liner. We don't have a Policy for work orders.</p>
