This failure had the potential to transmit infectious diseases. Findings: During an interview on 7/20/20, at 12:31 PM, with Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN 1), LVN 1 stated she was using Peroxide Multi-Surface Cleaner, Disinfectant Wipe and Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe to disinfect the medication cart and high touch areas (surfaces that have frequent contact with the hands such as tables, door knobs, light switch, countertops, handles) at the nurse's station. LVN 1 stated she does not know the dwell times for both disinfectants, after wiping, we just leave it dry for three minutes. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 12:36 PM, with Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), CNA stated she was using cleaning disinfectant Super Sani-Cloth Germicidal Disposable Wipe to clean the blood pressure machine and Hoyer lift (an electrical or mechanical assistive device to help a resident transfer from bed to wheelchair). CNA stated, I wipe it down a few times like 10 to 20 seconds. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 12:50 PM, with LVN 2, LVN 2 stated she was assigned to the [MEDICAL CONDITION] Disease 2019 (COVID-19 - an infectious disease caused by a new coronavirus) unit and uses cleaning disinfectant Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe and leaves the medication cart and high touch areas wet for 30 seconds. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 12:55 PM, with Housekeeper (HK 1), she stated she was assigned to the COVID-19 unit, HK 1 stated, I use Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe to clean high touch areas. I leave it wet for about two minutes and then I let it dry for five minutes. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 1:51 PM, with HK 2, HK 2 stated she was using cleaning disinfectants Peroxide Multi-Surface Cleaner and Disinfectant Wipe and Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe and does not know the dwell times for both disinfectants. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 2:00 PM, with HK 3, HK 3 stated she was using cleaning disinfectant Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe and does not know the dwell time for disinfectant. During an interview on 7/20/20, at 2:06 PM with HK 4, HK 4 stated she was using cleaning disinfectant Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe and does not know the dwell time for disinfectant. During a concurrent interview and record review, on 7/20/20, at 1:15 PM, with the Infection Preventionist (IP), IP stated, I thought we keep (Super Sani-Cloth Germicidal Disposable Wipe) wet for one minute and the (Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe) wet for two minutes. The manufacturer label on dwell times was reviewed for cleaning disinfectants and noted the following: 1. Peroxide Multi-Surface Cleaner and Disinfectant Wipe dwell time of three minutes. 2. Super Sani-Cloth Germicidal Disposable Wipe dwell time of two minutes. 3. Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe dwell time of four minutes. During a review of the facility's policy and procedure (P&amp;P) titled Fresh Impressions How to clean computer workstations, keyboards, kiosks and medication carts, dated 7/19, it indicated, Follow manufacturer instructions when using chemicals and disinfecting. 2. Solution that cleans and disinfects which could include II. Disinfectant wipes. During a review of the facility's policy and procedure titled, Cleaning &amp; Disinfection of Resident Rooms, dated 7/19, the P&amp;P indicated, 3. Cleaning should be done with a community-approved detergent and/or EPA-registered disinfectant in accordance with manufacturer instructions.</p>
