The preceding list represents the additional hospitals that are eligible, for the FY 2012 IPPS-LTCH proposed rule, to have their wage index increased by the out-migration adjustment listed in this table. The adjustment is effective for 3 years. Hospitals cannot receive the out-migration adjustment if they are reclassified under section 1886(d)(10) of the Act or redesignated under section 1886(d)(8)(B) of the Act. Hospitals that have already been reclassified under section 1886(d)(10) of the Act or redesignated under section 1886(d)(8)(B) of the Act are designated with an asterisk. We will automatically assume that hospitals that have already been reclassified under section 1886(d)(10) of the Act or redesignated under section 1886(d)(8)(B) of the Act wish to retain their reclassification/redesignation status and waive the application of the out-migration adjustment. Section 1886(d)(10) hospitals that wish to receive the out-migration adjustment, rather than their reclassification, must follow the termination/withdrawal procedures specified in the Correction Notice (CMS-1518-CN2; to be displayed in the ***Federal Register*** sometime during the week of July 4, 2011). Specifically, such hospitals must notify the MGCRB and CMS that they elected to receive the out-migration adjustment instead of their section 1886(d)(10) reclassification within 7 days of the display date of the Correction Notice. Otherwise, they will be deemed to have waived the out-migration adjustment. Hospitals redesignated under section 1886(d)(8)(B) of the Act will be deemed to have waived the out-migration adjustment, unless they explicitly notify CMS that they elected to receive the out-migration adjustment instead within 7 days of the display of the Correction Notice.
